

# ARE YOU PREPARED?

**OUR GOAL IS TO NEGOTIATE A FAIR CONTRACT WITHOUT A STRIKE, BUT IN THE EVENT THAT IS NOT POSSIBLE, HERE ARE SOME TIPS FOR BEING PREPARED:**

- TAKE ADVANTAGE OF MAIL ORDER PRESCRIPTIONS FOR MAINTENANCE DRUGS, I.E. BLOOD PRESSURE, DIABETES, ETC. YOU CAN GET A 90-DAY SUPPLY WHICH CAN CARRY YOU INTO MAY
- DON'T MAKE UNNECESSARY MAJOR PURCHASES
- ANY PURCHASES ON CREDIT SHOULD HAVE DEFERRED PAYMENTS
- BUILD UP YOUR SAVINGS ACCOUNT AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE
- TAKE OUT SAVINGS PLAN LOAN/CONSUMER LOAN IN ADVANCE. DEPOSIT INTO YOUR SAVINGS
- FILING TAXES QUICKLY AND ELECTRONICALLY WILL USUALLY REFUND 1-2 WKS
- BE AWARE OF COBRA MEDICAL COVERAGE FOR YOU AND PEACH CARE MEDICAL COVERAGE FOR YOUR CHILDREN
- TALK TO CREDITORS ABOUT DEFERRING OR PAYING INTEREST ONLY ON LOANS IF THERE IS A STRIKE
- LOOK FOR PART-TIME WORK OPPORTUNITIES
- BE AWARE THAT THE UNION WILL HAVE A GOOD AND WELFARE COMMITTEE TO PROVIDE HELP WITH FOOD BANKS, UTILITY BILLS, ETC
